A high profile Cruise Ship needed a decorative and ergonomic flooring system within its Medical room; tight ship turn around times meant quick application and cure times would be necessary. Special coving would also be required to offer the best possible cleaning and hygiene performance. The specification would also need long term flexibility and be waterproof, with a seamless design continuing through the coved edges.

Then the Bond Coat, underlayment edges and infill repairs were completed the first day and left to dry overnight. The full flexible resin system with chosen flake color scheme was added the following morning and allowed to dry overnight. The seal coats were applied the next morning the next day and within a few hours handed back into operation.
